## Race Induction 2018

By signing this race induction sheet, I hereby state that I have read and understood what is required for me to race with the Griffith Cycle Club. I will strictly abide by all race conditions and instructions from race officials.

I also acknowledge that road cycle racing can be considered a dangerous sport, and whilst all reasonable care is taken by the race organizers and officials when organizing this event, I understand that as a participating rider I have an equal responsibility to ensure that I take all reasonable care by adhering to the road rules and any other conditions imposed by Police and or officials ensuring a safe race environment for all concerned.

1. All riders must have a road worthy racing bike that also conforms to the requirements of the UCI.
2. All riders must wear a Standards Australia approved helmet, correctly fitted and fastened.
3. All riders must wear an approved race jersey and cycling knicks.
4. All riders must wear an approved race number on the lower left hand side on the back of their racing jersey whilst they are racing. This number is to be removed if the rider drops out or is removed from the race.
5. Any rider removed or dropping out of the race is no longer part of the race event.
6. All road rules are to be strictly adhered to.
7. All riders must exercise caution in relation to other road users. Riders must always be aware of the other riders within their group and exercise caution for the safety of the whole group.
8. Intersections can be a place of increased risk. Riders approaching an intersection must exercise caution in relation to the road conditions and any approaching traffic. Care must be taken to ensure that the whole group can safely negotiate an intersection before proceeding through it.
9. All riders have a responsibility to ensure that they know the course that they are to race on. If a rider has not ridden the course before it is the riders obligation to speak to the Race Starter to be briefed on the course particulars prior to the race start.
10. Riders must not ride over the centerline of the road.
11. After crossing the finish line all riders must keep the road carriageway clear and not obstruct traffic.
12. Any complaints regarding the race must be brought to the attention of either the Race Starter or the Commissaire.
